Mission

The **Center for Leadership & Civic Engagement (CLCE)** at the University of South Florida trains, educates, and develops USF community members to be effective, ethical, and positively engaged leaders among the global community. We do this through civic engagement, leadership education and student organization empowerment.

Background

The **Lunchtime Leadership Series** is a CLCE program where Tampa Bay community and corporate partners who practice ethical, empowering, and inclusive leadership are invited to campus to discuss leadership as it is practiced within their organization. This program provides students the chance to hear from experts across many different fields. As students learn leadership from our partners, partners have the opportunity to get 1:1 face time with the student population and have their name shared with students as a CLCE partner.

Presentation Template Suggestion

General Outline for Speaker:

- (2 min) CLCE staff member briefly introduces speaker
- (5 min) Speaker decides if they would like to allow students to introduce themselves (depending on the size of the group).
- (15 min) Speaker gives background on themselves, their career, their experience with leadership, their time in college, etc. Visual aids can be beneficial if they complement the content.
- (20-30 min) Speaker introduces the central topic(s) and relates it to their work. Discuss lessons they've learned, share personal stories, and apply theory from their field to the topic. This is also where a hands-on activity would happen if they choose to include one.
- (5-15 min) Allow for questions from students.

Notes

- Feel free to remain after the program to connect with students 1:1 or answer any lingering questions.
- Outline and presentation format are flexible.

- The office space has a computer and display, if you would like to share a PowerPoint, video, or slides.
- Group size, on average, is 15-20 students from across a variety of majors.

- Location: Marshall Student Center, 4103 USF Cedar Cir, Tampa, FL 33620. The Center for Leadership & Civic Engagement office is located on the first floor and presenters check in at suite 1300.
