Saint Leo University's MANE Event to Welcome New, Prospective Students on July 20

*Opportunities to Prepare for Fall 2024, Learn About Programs,
Explore Campus, Earn Microscholarships*

ST. LEO, FL – Saint Leo University will host its largest admissions event of the year, The MANE Event, for new and prospective undergraduate students, 8:30 a.m. to 3 p.m., Saturday, July 20, at University Campus, 33701 County 52, St. Leo, FL 33574. Students who have committed to joining Saint Leo for the Fall 2024 Semester, as well as those who still are making their college decision, will have the opportunity to experience the university's academics, community, and student services while completing preparations for August classes.

Light breakfast items will be served during check in, 8:30 – 9 a.m. and the university welcome will begin promptly at 9 a.m. Lunch will be available in the Dining Hall.

Incoming students and their families can complete New Student Checklist items while making new friends with other future Saint Leo Lions.

For high school and transfer students still deciding about college for this fall, The MANE Event will be an opportunity to receive an "instant admission" decision. To be considered for instant admission to Saint Leo, the student must complete and submit a Fall 2024 application by 11:59 p.m. (EDT), Thursday, July 18. At The MANE Event on July 20, students who have submitted their application will be able to provide transcripts and finalize their enrollment by submitting a deposit.

Event programming will include class registration with a Student Success Coach, financial aid meetings with Student Financial Services, housing selection and residence hall walk-throughs, and more. Students will get a taste of the experiential learning that Saint Leo offers with visits to the Robotics Lab and other venues.

Scholarship Opportunities

The MANE Event will offer two types of microsolarships as well as the chance to win a \$1,000 scholarship.

Fly-In and Drive-In microsolarships are:

- **Fly-In:** All out-of-state students who travel to attend The MANE Event may be eligible to earn a \$500 scholarship toward their first-year tuition at Saint Leo University.
- **Drive-In:** Florida resident students who attend The MANE Event may be eligible to earn a \$250 scholarship toward their first-year tuition at Saint Leo University.

In order to obtain a microsolarship, students must make their deposit by 11:59 p.m. (EDT), Sunday, July 21. The scholarship is only eligible for Fall Semester 2024 and will not apply to another term. The scholarship amount will be split between the Fall 204 and Spring 2025 semesters.

In addition, Saint Leo will award a \$1,000 scholarship to one lucky student who attends The MANE Event. The winner will be notified via email, and the microsolarships and this scholarship cannot be stacked.
